Dear Andy Scwartz,

I'm writing to you because I'm very concerned about the questionable state of your Prison Health Services, to fulfill the "intent" of your contract with the DOC in Alabama. I've been following the case of Patrick Swiney and his wrongful conviction very closely and it appears that the Alabama Department of Corrections and your Prison Health Services have totally criminalized health, where he is concerned. It is starting to look intentional.

It seems that Patrick Swiney is very ill with heart related problems and is having great difficulty breathing. He needs to see a cardiovascular surgeon, for an arteriogram, according to official Doctor's order in April, 2005, for diagnosis and bypass surgery. The Guards and Prison officials at Donaldson Correctional Facility have systematically ignored these orders. It has occurred to me that these said Prison Guards and Officials would like to see Patrick Swiney die before he can adjudicate his case of innocence and expose the real cover-up and perpetrators of the crime, in court.

This man is innocent and the way your state treats inmates, with health problems, is abominable. For years now, there has been ongoing, "documented" evidence of the horrible abuse you've made Patrick Swiney and the other inmates endure.

If Patrick Swiney doesn't get the swift and immediate healthcare he needs and is entitled to, I will personally help fund the ensuing "WRONGFUL DEATH" and "WRONGFUL CONVICTION" lawsuit.

This wonderful and loving man, who has never hurt anyone, has had his freedom taken away and has been deliberately harmed and abused and refused medical treatment.

Patrick needs help. As a prisoner at Donaldson Correctional Facility, he is at the mercy of corrupt and pathologically cruel jailers, who are distorting and "Not Doing" the job they're being paid, (with tax dollars), to do. Nevertheless, Patrick does have rights. He has the right to adequate medical care according to Law. And neither PHS nor DOC has the right to perpetrate callous indifference to his medical needs Estelle v Gamble, 429 US 97 (1976) "lack, or indifferent medical care, is a violation of the eighth amendment of the United States Constitution, and 42 USC § 1983."

As stated above, an immediate appointment with a Cardiovascular Surgeon for an arteriogram was ordered by the Prison Doctor, for Patrick Swiney, months ago. The PHS, DOC, LPN's and Guards at Donaldson have repeatedly ignored this order. THIS 60 YEAR OLD MAN WHO CANNOT BREATHE NORMALLY NEEDS TO SEE A CARDIOVASCULAR SURGEON NOW.

Patrick Swiney is provably innocent of a crime for which he was wrongfully convicted and has spent 16 torturous and unnecessary years in Prison for this. And now, your Prison Health Care System is denying him his basic human rights to necessary and immediate medical treatment.
