from South Carolina to Alabaster
and picked me up to go visit my
son who is not doing very well &

I went in and sat down for
at least thirty min. before she
got in. I saw the guard checked
me fully and I was allowed to

go to the visiting yard. She did not say anything about my clothes.

Right after I got to the visiting yard one of the guards came over and said (Lt? McSwain wanted me back down at the entrance area and that I had to go, and even though I can barely walk I went. This I feel was very cruel due to my age 84 and my disability. She told me that I had on a jogging suit but I had worn the pants with another shirt and had no problem with them.

The lady on the first desk admitting claimed I was yelling at her but I told her I had a hearing problem and just talked loud but she would not listen. Another
