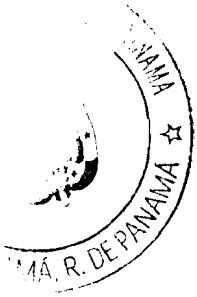
I, Sandra Cerrud, being a Criminal Attorney Licensed to practice Law in the Republic of Panama, do state Under Oath the following:

I state the following to be true and within my personal knowledge on a first hand basis.

1. The attached document and offer from Eddie Ray Kahn to the government of United States of America was delivered to the Embassy of the United States of America on October 25, 2006. David G. Wattley, he told me that my client, Eddie Ray Kahn, must immediately go by himself, without representation, to the United States of America and turn himself in. David G. Wattley did not want Eddie Ray Kahn to go to the Embassy of the United States of America to present his offer of compromise. David G. Wattley said that he would not accept Eddie Ray Kahn's Offer of Conditional Acceptance.
2. The following day, October 26, 2006, David G. Wattley told me by telephone that he would give Eddie Ray Kahn the opportunity to go to the United States of America by himself up to November 1, 2006. David G. Wattley stated that if Eddie Ray Kahn did not do as directed, he would be arrested after November 1, 2006. On Monday, October 30, 2006, David G. Wattley threatened that he would take away my United States of America visa and cause trouble for me. I continued to help Eddie Ray Kahn, my client. Eddie Ray Kahn was arrested on October 31, 2006.
3. Eddie Ray Kahn had an appointment with me and a reporter in my office on October 31, 2006 about 12:30 pm. Eddie Ray Kahn wanted to present his side of the story to the media with documentation. Eddie Ray Kahn told me that as he approached my office, he was apprehended by Thomas Garcia Tobar and a couple of other men from Panama Immigration. These men took Eddie Ray Kahn directly to the Ancon Jail.
4. Normal procedure in Panama is to do a police order and then get back to immigration before taking someone to jail. There were no papers in the jail to hold Eddie Ray Kahn. No one in Panama can be arrested and sent to the United States of America without an extradition order. Panama Immigration did not follow proper legal procedure. In fact, Eddie Ray Kahn told me that his attorney who prepared his Pensionado Visa was notified two weeks earlier by Panama Immigration by telephone that Eddie Ray Kahn's Visa was in order.
5. When I took Eddie Ray Kahn's wife to see him the Ancon jail, I asked Eddie Ray Kahn why he had told Ricardo Julio Vargas, Director of Panama Immigration, that he had no other problems with the government of the United States of America. Eddie Ray Kahn looked shocked and told me that he had told Ricardo Julio Vargas the he absolutely did have a civil bench warrant out for his arrest. Ricardo Julio Vargas lied about what Eddie Ray Kahn had said and made Eddie Ray Kahn look like the liar. Panama television showed a man in front of a Panama church and stated that Eddie Ray Kahn had told people that he was the pastor of that church. The gentleman at the church said that he did not know Eddie Ray Kahn and had never even seen him. This was not even the church that

Eddie Ray Kahn attended in Panama. Mrs. Kahn said that Eddie Ray Kahn never called himself a pastor.

- 6. The police chief, Mrs. Mina, shook Mrs. Kahn's hand, looked her in the eyes and told her not to worry that her husband had no orders to leave Panama the next day, and that he would not be flying out.
- 7. I immediately started the procedure for a Habeas Corpus order. Early on November 1, 2006, the Supreme Court of Panama accepted the Habeas Corpus order to stop the extradition. I went to the airport with my assistant to present the Habeas Corpus order to the airport immigration department. Eddie Ray Kahn was still in the airport and his flight had not departed. I showed the Habeas Corpus order from the Panama Supreme Court to the airport department of immigration. They would not accept the order and ignored my request. They said it was too late.

I swear and affirm under penalty of perjury that the above facts are true to the best of my personal knowledge.
